



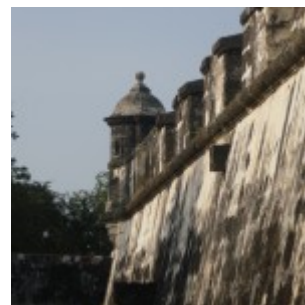
Posing at the turret

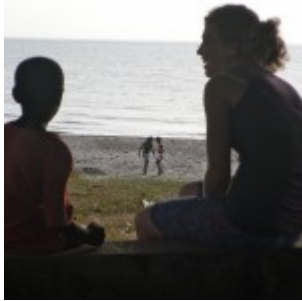

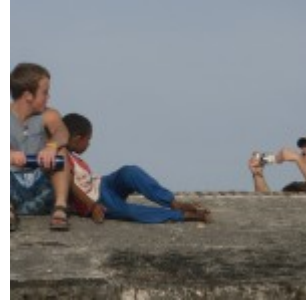
