We had a safe boat ride over to Cartegna and made it safely to our hotel. We dropped off

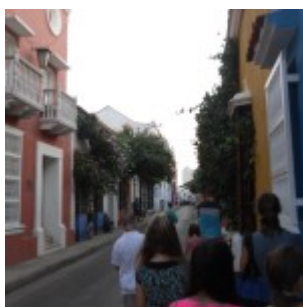

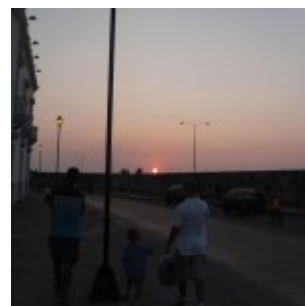

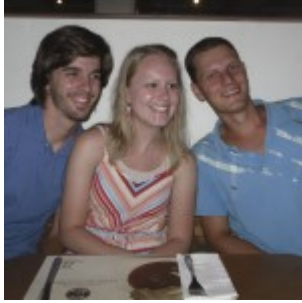
